Romans 8:26-27 KJV “Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.”

A person who is in Christ, in other words, one who is saved by faith in Jesus Christ has so many blessings. There are seven major or pillars of blessings found in Romans chapter 8 for the Christian. So many Christians are trying to live back in chapter 7, never gaining the victory over sin and living a life pleasing to the Lord when they need to be walking in the Spirit and living in chapter 8.

So far we have looked at four of the seven pillar of blessings found in chapter 8.

- 1st pillar - no condemnation - I have a pardon
- 2nd pillar - freedom to live - I have freedom
- 3rd pillar - adopted into the family of God - I have a Father
- 4th pillar - future joy - I have a future
